OBSERVATIONS AND ISSUES RAISED BY THE STUDENTS (22-10-2019)

The action points are as under:

1. B.E. third year (ENC) students raised the following issues: a) to appoint CS faculty for CS subjects b) Appending of 2 subject's Information Management Systems to be replaced by DBMS and Data Comm. & Computer Networks to be replaced by computer Networks c) to schedule classes from in TAN or LT block for next semester.

Action Point: DOAA/HCSSED/HECED

2. Some students of B.E. First year pointed out that their classes are held in the TAN Auditorium building (T205). There is a very poor visibility on the board due to which they are not able to preferably understand everything taught in our class.

Action Point: DOAA/HEAD CMS

3. Some students of PG 2nd year requested for revision of research project submission in 3rd semester for Masters of Psychology. They highlighted that the concerned students do not get enough time to complete the project as there is dissertation submission also. They requested to look into the

possibility of rescheduling the project and dissertation submissions, both during the 4th semester only.

Action Point: DOAA/HSRSS

4. B.E. third year (ECE) students raised their concern regarding ECE department taking COE subjects for ENC students. They requested that the CS faculty should teach the computer science related subject to ENC students as well.

Action Point: DOAA/HCSSED/HECED

5. Some students of Hostel N raised issues related to maintenance in hostel N. Hostel N needs immediate attention as the steel tiles are falling from the roof. There is also a lot of fungus in Hostel –N. they requested that these issues be addressed as early as possible, as it is affecting the health of the students.

6. B.E. first year (ECE) students raised their points regarding the issue of white board visibility in many rooms of the TAN building. meeting. Some of the important issues which had come to the office of the Dean, students were shared with all the members of SCC. Prof Gopalan specifically addressed the issue of late hostel entry/exit timings for the girl students. The affidavit to be signed by the parents of the girl students, regarding the hostel entry/exit timings, was discussed and approved for implementation from this session itself. For the convenience and information of all hostellers, the clarifications related to the implementation of new laundry contract and the mess fee paid to Sodexo was also provided to the members of the SCC.

Although, many of the points raised by the students during the meeting could be discussed and clarifications were provided, but some points still merit further attention and action.

OBSERVATIONS AND ISSUES RAISED BY THE STUDENTS (23-01-2020)

The action points are as under:

14. The issue related to the implementation of CBCS (Choice Based Credit System) was brought up as an agenda item by many students. It was informed that CBCS is already existing in the schemes of all departments, however, it was decided that the Dean of Academic Affairs would make a detailed presentation in the next SCC meeting for benefit of all students.

Action Point: DOAA

15. The students wanted that the reconciliation and verification of fee paid by the students (specially the hostel and mess fee) through Paytm be made digital, rather than printing the same. It was agreed upon in principle and shall be implemented from next academic year (2020-21).

Action Point: ADOSA-1 and ADOSA-2

16. B.E. third year students pointed out that water coolers are there only on the alternate floors in Hostel - M. They also highlighted that there is a provision to accommodate the water cooler on each floor, so why not have water coolers on each floor itself.

Action Point: HEAD CMS/MR. CHANDAN KUMAR

17. Some students of girl hostels of B.E. third year and also of one of the boy's hostels pointed out that the amount of food cooked in hostels is less than required.

Action Point: ADOSA-1/WARDEN HOSTEL-E, I, G, FRDE

18. Some students of B.E. third year pointed that the books in the Library (Electrical Department) required upgradation and more volumes. Books of power system such as Modern Power System analysis by DP Kothari have pages missing in it. They also said that the some of the available books are of older editions. They also highlighted that books such as on Switchgear & Protection are not available in the library.

Action Point: HEIED/HNNCL

19. The students of the Hostel – M complained that treadmill is not working in hostel for the last 6 months.

Action Point: ADOSA-1/WARDEN HOSTEL-M

20. First year students in Hostel FRE raised their point that there are only two water coolers. They said that these are insufficient and there is a requirement for more water coolers. Students also stressed that CCTV cameras in hostel FRE should be installed at all critical locations.

Action Point: ADOSA-2/WARDEN HOSTEL-FRE/ HEAD CMS

21. ME/M. Tech Students pointed out that there should no extra classes during the reading week. They also complained that GATE & Non-GATE scholarship is not being provided in time.

Action Point: DOAA/FO

22. Students of hostel N requested that more gender sensitization programs be organized for the guards on campus.

Action Point: ADOSA-1/ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER

23. Students of B.E. third year (ECE) have issues regarding the unavailability of PC's in lab for DSA.

Action Point: HECED

24. Students of B.E. (ELE) third year pointed out that they have four subjects of core in 7th semester. It will very difficult for them to manage placement and studies altogether due to higher teaching load.

Action Point: DOAA/HEIED

25. Students of B.E. (EIC) second year requested that they should have a platform that connects them directly to their teachers (group teachers) to pass on information such as notes/ announcement.

Action Point: DOAA/HEIED

26. Some students of M.E. Thermal & CAD CAM pointed that they have not received GATE & Non-GATE scholarships. Moreover, both branches students had problem of erroneous account numbers in the finance department side.

Action Point: DOAA/HMED/FO

27. Students of M. Sc. (Biotechnology) second year pointed out that they are pursuing their project semester and some students are not getting proper equipment and chemicals for carrying out their experiments. Some of them have to do characterization of their samples which costs around Rs.10000/- (each) and there is no contingency for the same while the other departments are getting it.

Action Point: DOAA/HBTD

28. Students of M. Sc.(Biotechnology) first year pointed out that all of their classes take place in R & D block in room RD-1. Since, construction work is going on, they have face lots of dust, noise & disturbance. So they requested that the classes be shifted somewhere else till the time construction is going on.

Action Point: DOAA/HBTD/TIME TABLE COORDINATOR

29. The issues related to the reduced connectivity of the Wi-Fi network on campus, specifically in the hostels, during the examination days was raised by many students. HCITM was requested look into this and increase the Wi-Fi bandwidth.

Action Point: HCITM

The first SCC meeting of the even semester of the session 2019-20 started with a welcome note by Dr. Maneek Kumar (DOSA) and an address by Prof. Prakash Gopalan, Director, TIET. He addressed all the faculty, staff and student members of the committee present. All the student members of the SCC were informed about the functioning of the SCC and it was emphasized that all students' representatives must consult their respective class/group before coming for SCC

meeting. Some of the important issues which had come to the office of the Dean, students were shared with all the members of SCC. The Dean, Students also elaborated the steps taken by the Institute to settle the issues and also discussed in detail the progress made by the institute with regards to the same. He also highlighted some of the important steps Institute has taken to ensure safety and security of students on TIET campus.

Prof Gopalan specifically addressed the issue of late hostel entry/exit timings for the girl students. The affidavit to be signed by the parents of the girl students, regarding the hostel entry/exit timings, was discussed and approved for implementation from this session itself. The format has to be made available on the TIET website.

For the convenience and information of all hostellers, the clarifications related to the implementation of new laundry contract and the mess fee paid to Sodexo was also provided to the members of the SCC.

Subsequently, the students were asked to express their concerns and views regarding academic and other matters.

Although, many of the points raised by the students during the meeting could be discussed and clarifications were provided, but some points still merit further attention and action.

The concerned faculty/staff members are requested to kindly inform the office of the Dean, Students Affairs about the action taken with regards to the same. **The necessary information may kindly be provided by February 14, 2020.**

OBSERVATIONS AND ISSUES RAISED BY THE STUDENTS (23-01-2020)

The action points are as under:

30. The issue related to the implementation of CBCS (Choice Based Credit System) was brought up as an agenda item by many students. It was informed that CBCS is already existing in the schemes of all departments, however, it was decided that the Dean of Academic Affairs would make a detailed presentation in the next SCC meeting for benefit of all students.

Action Point: DOAA

31. The students wanted that the reconciliation and verification of fee paid by the students (specially the hostel and mess fee) through Paytm be made digital, rather than printing the same. It was agreed upon in principle and shall be implemented from next academic year (2020-21).

Action Point: ADOSA-1 and ADOSA-2

32. B.E. third year students pointed out that water coolers are there only on the alternate floors in Hostel - M. They also highlighted that there is a provision to accommodate the water cooler on each floor, so why not have water coolers on each floor itself.

Action Point: HEAD CMS/MR. CHANDAN KUMAR

33. Some students of girl hostels of B.E. third year and also of one of the boy's hostels pointed out that the amount of food cooked in hostels is less than required.

Action Point: ADOSA-1/WARDEN HOSTEL-E, I, G, FRDE

34. Some students of B.E. third year pointed that the books in the Library (Electrical Department) required upgradation and more volumes. Books of power system such as Modern Power System analysis by DP Kothari have pages missing in it. They also said that the some of the available books are of older editions. They also highlighted that books such as on Switchgear & Protection are not available in the library.

Action Point: HEIED/HNNCL

35. The students of the Hostel – M complained that treadmill is not working in hostel for the last 6 months.

Action Point: ADOSA-1/WARDEN HOSTEL-M

36. First year students in Hostel FRE raised their point that there are only two water coolers. They said that these are insufficient and there is a requirement for more water coolers. Students also stressed that CCTV cameras in hostel FRE should be installed at all critical locations.

Action Point: ADOSA-2/WARDEN HOSTEL-FRE/ HEAD CMS

37. ME/M. Tech Students pointed out that there should no extra classes during the reading week. They also complained that GATE & Non-GATE scholarship is not being provided in time.

Action Point: DOAA/FO

38. Students of hostel N requested that more gender sensitization programs be organized for the guards on campus.

Action Point: ADOSA-1/ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER

39. Students of B.E. third year (ECE) have issues regarding the unavailability of PC's in lab for DSA.

Action Point: HECED

40. Students of B.E. (ELE) third year pointed out that they have four subjects of core in 7th semester. It will very difficult for them to manage placement and studies altogether due to higher teaching load.

Action Point: DOAA/HEIED

41. Students of B.E. (EIC) second year requested that they should have a platform that connects them directly to their teachers (group teachers) to pass on information such as notes/ announcement.

Action Point: DOAA/HEIED

42. Some students of M.E. Thermal & CAD CAM pointed that they have not received GATE & Non-GATE scholarships. Moreover, both branches students had problem of erroneous account numbers in the finance department side.

Action Point: DOAA/HMED/FO

43. Students of M. Sc. (Biotechnology) second year pointed out that they are pursuing their project semester and some students are not getting proper equipment and chemicals for carrying out their experiments. Some of them have to do characterization of their samples which costs around Rs.10000/- (each) and there is no contingency for the same while the other departments are getting it.

Action Point: DOAA/HBTD

44. Students of M. Sc.(Biotechnology) first year pointed out that all of their classes take place in R & D block in room RD-1. Since, construction work is going on, they have face lots of dust, noise & disturbance. So they requested that the classes be shifted somewhere else till the time construction is going on.

Action Point: DOAA/HBTD/TIME TABLE COORDINATOR

45. The issues related to the reduced connectivity of the Wi-Fi network on campus, specifically in the hostels, during the examination days was raised by many students. HCITM was requested look into this and increase the Wi-Fi bandwidth.

Action Point: HCITM
